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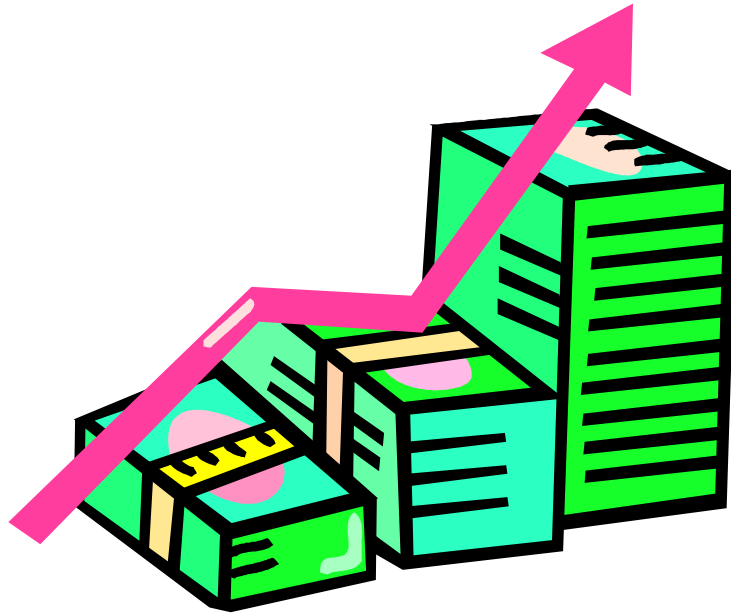

# Are they being used?

- Flat World Knowledge reported adoptions at over 2,000 colleges and universities for use by over 300,000 students in August, 2011
