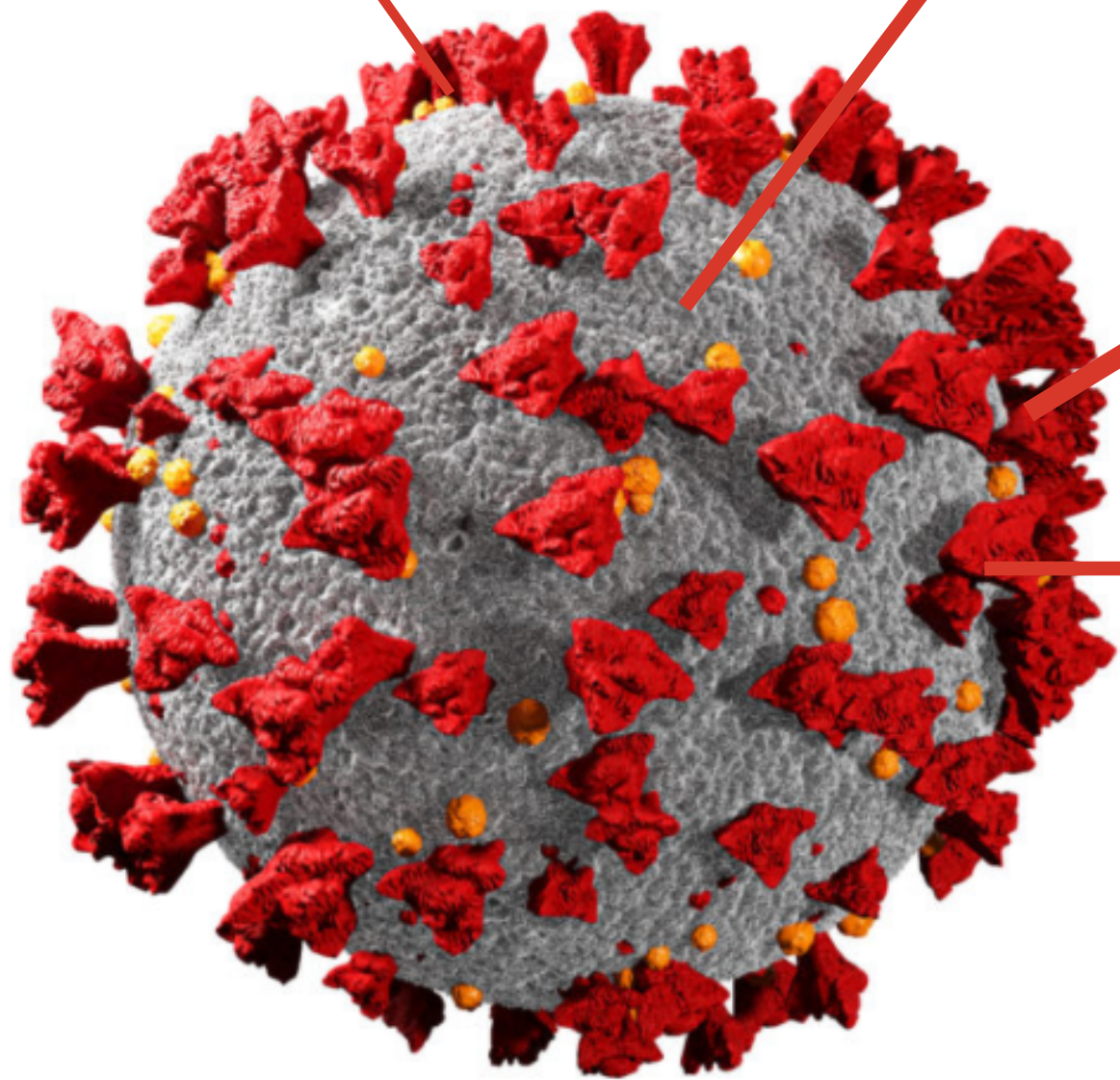

6 of every 100 kids with COVID-19 can show severe symptoms

2 of every 100 kids (ages 5-18) with COVID-19 are hospitalized

Symptoms: Bad stomach pain, high fever, rash, irregular heartbeats



Kids (5-18 years old) have spread about 26% of the disease

How you can help:

- Kids can spread COVID-19, do your part!
- Wear a mask and keep 6ft. distance
- Play games like hide-and-seek and online video games not tag.
