

Expert Opinions:


- **No studies support the myth**
- No studies have found a significant difference in patient survival between patients treated with corticosteroids and those treated without

CDC Recommends:

- Limit corticosteroid usage to severe Covid-19 patients or those that require aggressive treatment
- Corticosteroids are not a COVID-19 cure
- For most patients, corticosteroids are not a treatment

Research Shows

- **No overall benefit** of corticosteroids to COVID-19 patients who are not severely ill.
- Even in very sick patients, the benefits of corticosteroids may not outweigh the **risks**.
