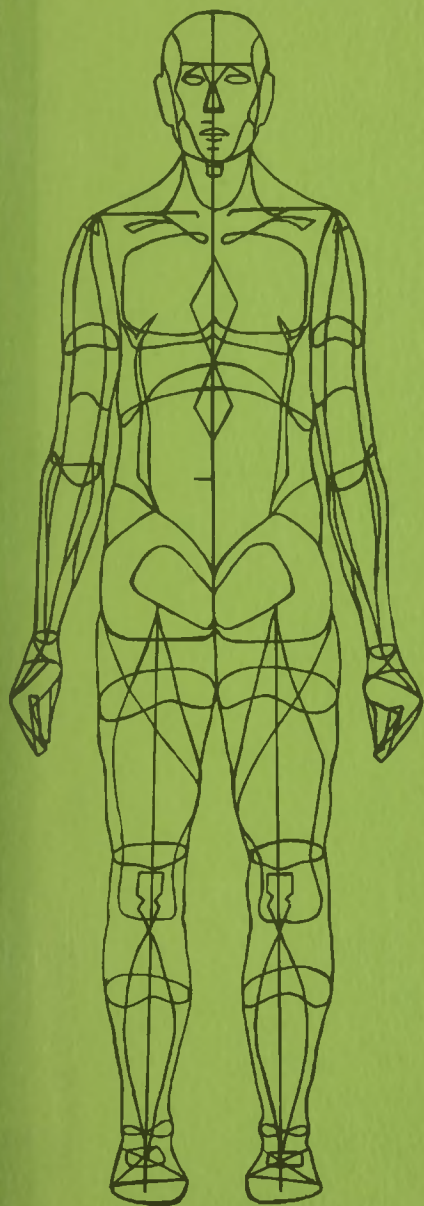

In conjunction with the forthcoming International Congress of Anthropological and Ethnological Sciences, the above-named organizations are sponsoring a pre-Congress meeting at the Wayne State University School of Medicine, Detroit, Michigan, August 28 through 31, 1973. In addition to an invited one-day symposium, contributed papers are being sought. Titles and abstracts should be sent to Dr. Elizabeth Watts, Anthropology Research Center, Tulane University, New Orleans, Louisiana, U.S.A.; completed manuscripts must be received by June 1, 1973. Papers will be published in a separate volume, by Mouton and Company, in the series *World Anthropology*, the Proceedings of the Congress.

The Local Arrangements Committee consists of Gabriel Lasker, Department of Anatomy, Chairman, Morris Goodman, Department of Anatomy, Mark Weiss, Department of Anthropology and Kazutoshi Mayeda, Department of Biology.

Individuals attending the meeting in Detroit may reserve rooms for themselves by writing to the Detroit Hilton Hotel, 1565 Washington Boulevard, Detroit. Room rates of \$16 per day (single), \$22 per day (double), and \$6.50 per person per day (quad) will obtain for those identifying themselves as conference attendees.

The advance registration fee for the conference will be \$15.00. This will include bus transportation from the hotel to the actual meeting site at the Medical School and return, and lunch for each of the three days. *Advance registration is necessary for those desiring lunch*; please mail your registration fee with covering letter to Dr. Watts, at the above address, by August 10, 1973.

Further information may be obtained from the conference organizers, Dr. Francis E. Johnston, Department of Anthropology, Temple University, Philadelphia, Pa., 19122, or Dr. Elizabeth Watts. The conference should provide an international forum for the exchange of data and ideas on topics of significance to human biologists and it is hoped that all who are able will take advantage of the opportunity. By registering well in advance, individuals will assist the organizing committee in planning for an efficient and effective conference.
